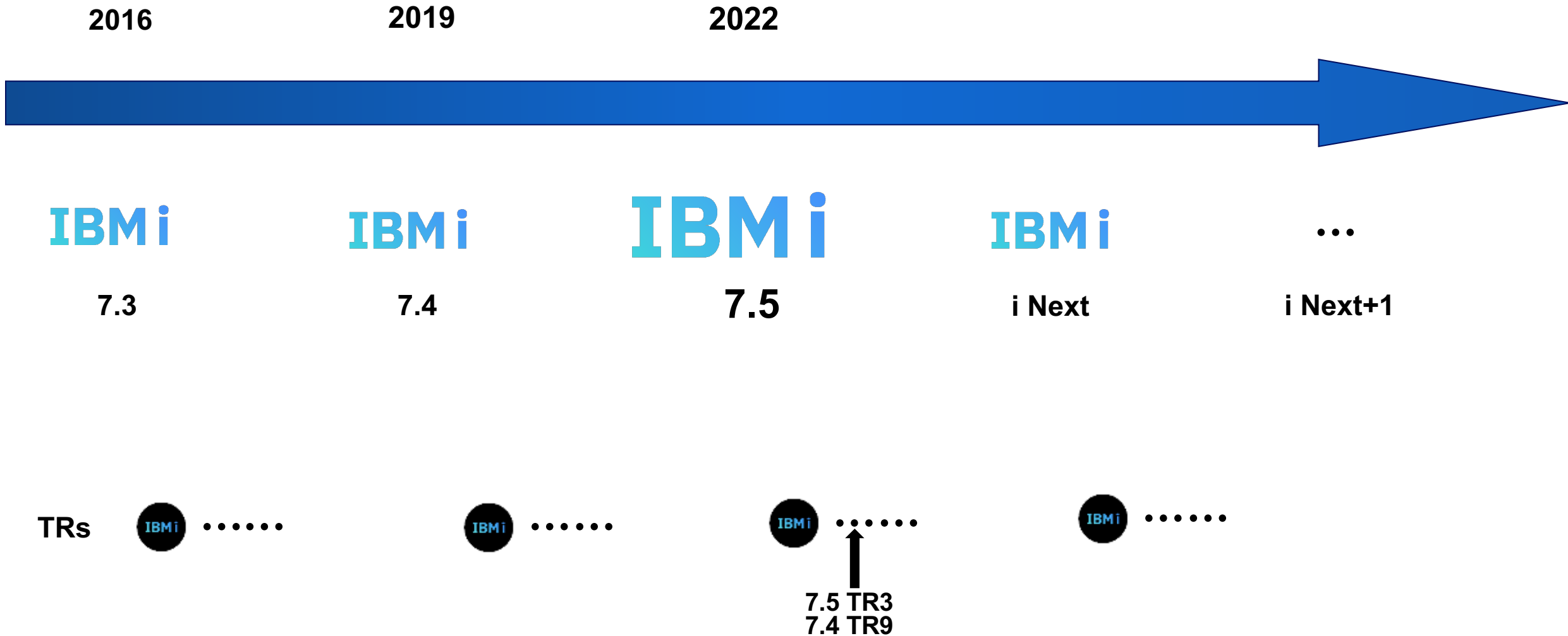

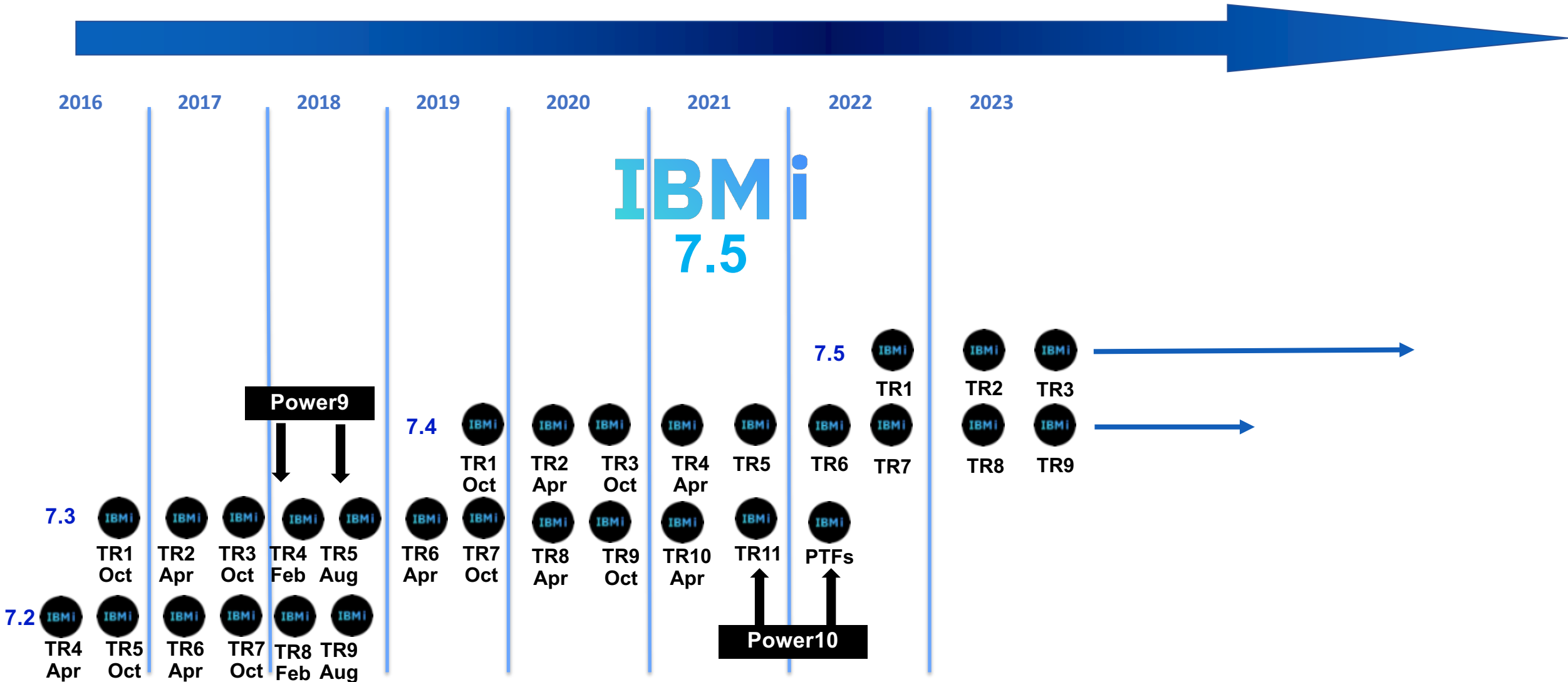

# IBM i Release Roadmap – Announcement Dates

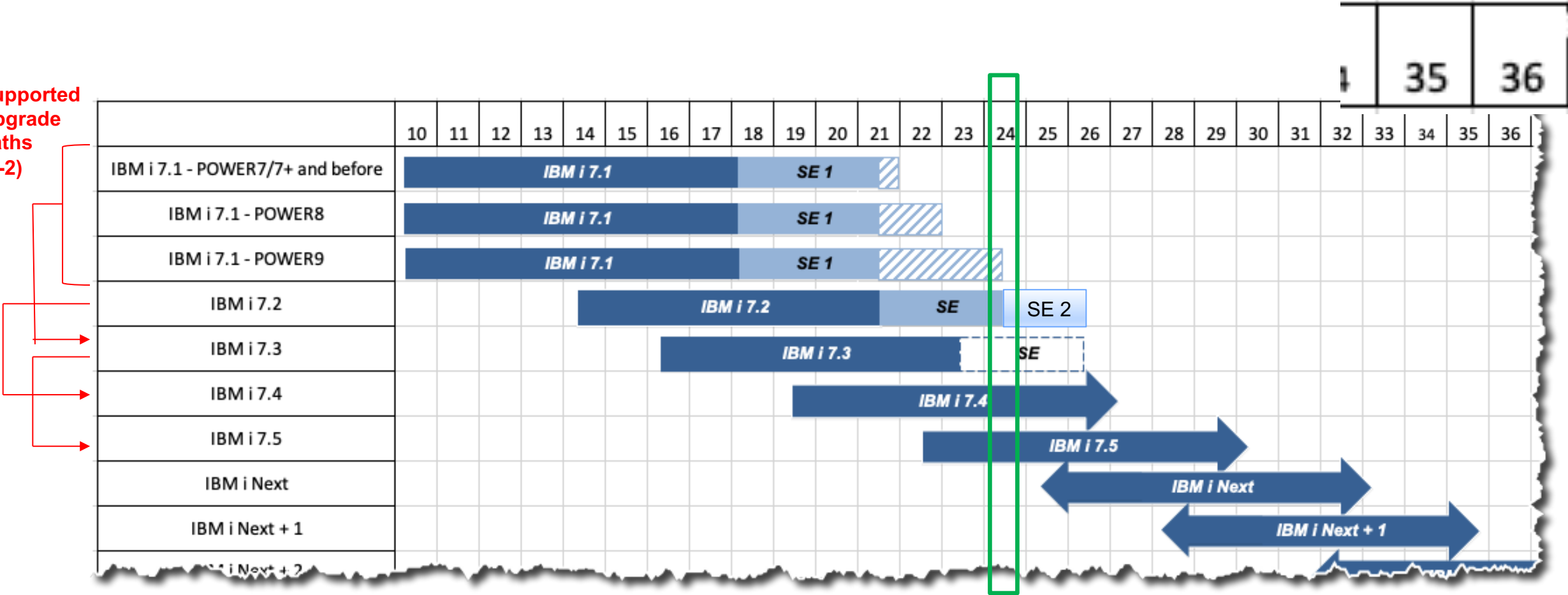

# What IBM i Delivers

- Major Releases
  - Db2: Temporal (7.3), Db2 Mirror (7.4), Boolean & 10 x Max size (7.5)
  - Security: Authority Collection – Users (7.3) Objects (7.4), Encryption & Audit (7.5)
    - Inspect the authority users have to data and software
    - Identify any exposures
    - Prove those exposures are locked down
  - Power family support
  - Customer requests which require pervasive changes
- Off-Release – Technology Refreshes and other mechanisms
  - Application Development Languages & Tools
    - RPG Free Format and “make RPG ‘normal’” additions to the language
    - RDi, Merlin, VS Code, Python, Java, Node.js, Git, Jenkins ...
  - Graphical Management and Access
    - ACS (Access Client Solutions) – Java based
    - Navigator – Browser-based
  - New Power, I/O & Virtualization capabilities
  - Customer requests which can be delivered quickly

# IBM i 7.5 TR3, IBM i 7.4 TR9 – Announce 10/10/2023



## IBM i Operating System

- Security
  - Multiple domain names and multiple IP addresses in DCM
- Data compression expanded to include save and restore for tape, including virtual tape

## Db2 for i

- Support for many REST capabilities
- SQL Commands extended beyond the database
  - Now includes procedures and functions
- Db2 for i Services can capture deep detail for SQL Statements in Plan Cache
- IBM i Services includes new services for exploring journals and system values
- SYSTOOLS function adds more capabilities for system administrators

## HA/DR

- PowerHA
  - Simple user defined tracking
  - Enhanced visibility to status of job at the time of failure
  - Simplified resubmission of jobs active at the time of failure
- Db2 Mirror
  - Health Center GUI improved allows easier gathering information
  - Updates for using mirrored data queues and resynchronization

## Hardware Features for IBM i

- Exploitation of selected offerings from IBM Power

## Application Modernization and Open Source

- IWS
  - Monitoring for null field values in request and response payloads
- VS Code
  - An open source alternative for application development has added enhancements to the IBM i interfaces and new extensions to work with Db2 for i
- Rational Development Studio – RPG Specific
  - DCL-ENUM definition group for qualified named constants
  - %LEFT and %RIGHT new string built-in functions
- Rational Developer for i
  - New templates added to RDi for iDoc templates
    - Spacing of header and footer lines

## System Management

- Navigator for i
  - Table filter improvements across much of the product
  - Directly edit the DNS configuration root servers
  - Improvements to the UI specifically for IFS views
  - Remote print queues added to Printing support
  - Enhancements to Work Management capabilities
  - Security views and capabilities expanded
- ACS
  - Enhancements to RUNSQL Scripts, SQL DML Statement generation and extensions to support IFS
  - Open source package management allows password protected SSH keys

# IBM i Services, ACS, Navigator, Ansible

- IBM i Services
  - SQL-based “APIs” (service calls)
  - Get information from IBM i which was once only available via commands/APIs
  - Perform operations on IBM i from “anywhere” with SQL
- Ansible
  -  – IBM i playbooks are being used by larger clients and service providers
  - Key technology for automation
- Navigator
  -  – GUI into IBM i management & visualization
  - Best tool for managing multiple IBM i partitions/machines
  - Browser-based - “Lightest” UI – available from anywhere
  - Performance, Security & more
- Access Client Solutions
  - GUI into IBM i management & visualization
  - Java-based with integrated tools which are not available via command line
  - Use of IBM i Services and example/templates for IBM i Services

# Key Recent IBM i Security Features

- Authority Collection (7.3 & 7.4)
  - Inspect the authority users have to data and software
  - Identify any exposures
  - Prove those exposures are locked down
- Strongest possible password hashing (7.5)
  - SHA2/3 encryption for Password hashing
  - New Password Level (QPWDLVL) system value (4)
    - Password Based Key Derivation Function 2 (PBKDF2) with SHA2-512
- Security by Default (7.5)
  - Memo to Users includes dozens of security updates
    - Default \*PUBLIC authority more restrictive on created objects
    - Special authority requirements added to some interfaces
- Default \*PUBLIC Authority on System Supplied Objects (7.5)
  - \*PUBLIC authority changed from \*CHANGE or \*ALL to \*USE for 100s of shipped objects
  - Use Memo to Users list of object to make changes on prior releases

## IBM plans to shift the IBM i portfolio to subscription term licensing 8/29/2023

1. Withdraw the ability to order non-expiring P05 & P10 tier licenses effective 5/7/2024.
2. Statements of Direction (SoD) IBM intends to offer IBM i customers a lower priced subscription term option to convert from an IBM i non-expiring license which has associated active Software Maintenance to an IBM i subscription term license.
